

HORSEMEN'S BOOKKEEPER--TRAINERS' PAYMENTS SURVEY

This Horsemen's Bookkeeper survey specifically sought to find whether TRA member tracks process the payments of fees and winnings to trainers through the Bookkeeper in the same manner jockeys' fees are handled. Of the 25 responses, 16 tracks are in control of their Horsemen's Bookkeeper, with five of those 16 processing trainer's payments through the Bookkeeper.

The following tracks run the Horsemen's Bookkeeper and process trainers' fees and winnings:

Del Mar: Is generally well received and has lessened conflict between owners and trainers

Meadowlands/Monmouth Park: Has been well received by horsemen

Penn National: Is generally well received and has lessened conflict between owners and trainers

Santa Anita Park: Is generally well received and has lessened conflict between owners and trainers. However, the payment to trainers seems to be a problem for out-of-state trainers who do not realize the system automatically defaults to pay the trainer, as they usually have their own payment agreement. Also, there are a few trainers who prefer to bill their owners. Some, especially those with many owners, opt out.
